The yearly calls so far are 8,670. In November there were 773 calls, 62 citations and 1 arrest. We have three applicants for the police job opening with interviews tomorrow.

<u>Laurie Hellstrom</u>: the city received a \$9.5K refund on the PEHP insurance. You have the list of businesses for renewals in your packets.

Tyson Jackson: we are wrapping up certifications and finalizing the trailhead.

<u>CM Gibson</u>: with no rain what is happening with the springs? <u>Tyson Jackson</u>: the booster station is not running. The springs are lower. Two wells are running regularly. It is trending in the wrong direction for the year.

<u>CM Arrington</u>: the newsletter looks good.

<u>CM Bailey</u>: we as a council work well together though we may disagree.

CM Urry: I agree with CM Bailey. The Santa event is December 12th.

CM Marriott: I like the Chief's comments on the parade. I agree with CM Bailey.

<u>CM Gibson</u>: a shout out thanks to the Straw Market for the Thanksgiving meals. Should there be letter from the city? <u>Mayor Call</u>: they should be personally thanked.
