

ORDINANCE 2023-13

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PLEASANT VIEW MUNICIPAL CODE § 2.33.120 – AMENDING AND CLARIFYING CIRCUMSTANCES JUSTIFYING AWARD OF CONTRACT WITHOUT COMPETITION.

WHEREAS, Pleasant View City has determined a need to modify its ordinances regarding the ability to sole-source and award contractual agreements without competition in certain situations; and

WHEREAS, these proposed modifications address specifically goods and services are procured through Utah State Procurement Contracts, provided by other governmental entities, provided by a contractor with a past working relationship with the city who retains historic knowledge and data of benefit to the City, for utility services, or when the City Council makes a formal determination that doing so is beneficial to the City; and

WHEREAS, Pleasant View City finds that such an ordinance amendment is in the best interest of the City.

NOW THEREFORE, Be it hereby ordained that:

SECTION ONE: Chapter 18.32.020 shall hereby be amended as follows:


2.33.120 Circumstances Justifying Award of Contract Without Competition. A contract may be awarded for a supply, services, or construction item without competition during the following situations:

- A. For goods or services that are secured through State Procurement Contracts;
- B. For goods and services made available by any federal, state or local unit of government, or association of government, when those goods or services were acquired in compliance with the provisions of the Utah procurement code;
- C. When the purchasing agent determines in writing and recorded on an Informal Price Quotation Record that there is only one source for the required supply, service, or construction item; ~~or~~
- D. When the award to a supplier, service provider, or contractor is a condition of a donation that will fund the full cost of the supply, service, or construction item;
- E. For utility services such as water, electric power, natural gas, telephone and fiber;
- F. When the City determines the continuation, expansion or renewal of goods or services with a company who is currently engaged by or who has priorly been engaged by the City and remains in good standing with the City; or
- G. When the City Council enters into a contract for goods or services and identifies why it is in the best interest of the City to pursue a contract.

SECTION TWO: This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval and posting.
